Impound

Bikes will be impounded in the Parc Ferme on Saturday night only. Riders will be given a 15 minute work period Sunday morning before their start time. For complete rules see the above noted websites.

The Course

150 km of trail each day including the Extreme, MX, and Enduro tests. Amateur riders will ride the entire course. Pro & Expert riders will have some extra sections of trail that they must complete.

Vintage, Women, and Beginner classes will run a shortened course on both Saturday and Sunday of approximately 80 to 100 km each day.

Special Tests

Special test times are not just tie breakers but are part of the riders overall score. MX and Extreme test courses will be laid out and marked by 9:00 am Friday, September 23rd so that riders may walk them if they wish. Directions to the tests will be available at the registration area at 9:00 am on Friday.

Endurocross Test by Cliffshore Adventures

The Endurocross will be at the start/finish area. Pro and Expert class riders will compete at the end of day 1, five riders at a time, for four laps. Rider times will be added to their scores.

Riders from other classes who wish to try the Endurocross may do so, but it is optional. Times will not be added to their scores and they will be competing for prizes only which will be awarded to the top three on Sat. night after dinner.

Sound Test

Friday, Sept. 23rd 4:00pm to 10:00pm and Saturday, September. 24th, 7:00am to 9:00am. Bikes must be sound tested before riders can register. A maximum 94db will be strictly enforced (we will not lose our trails because of unnecessarily loud motorcycles).

Vintage

In addition to the Vintage Class in the enduro, there will be a Vintage Enduro Bike Show & Shine. Awards will be presented at Saturday's dinner. Bikes must be on display Saturday afternoon at the start/finish area. There are no fees to enter the Show & Shine.

Awards

Corduroy trophies will only be awarded on Sunday afternoon based on total score for both days. Every rider who completes both days will receive a Finisher's medal.

Machine Racing Tire Change Contest

There will be a tire change contest on Saturday sponsored by Machine Racing. A set of tires will be awarded to fastest Pro rider and the fastest Amateur rider. Participation is optional.

Gas trucks supplied by Foran's Roofing

Gas trucks will be provided both days by Foran's Roofing. Be sure to bring 2 gas cans with your name marked clearly on them.

Saturday Trail Ride by Rally Connex

There will be a trail ride on Sat for anyone who wants to enjoy the Corduroy in a non-competitive format. The trail will be run on a completely separate course. Trail riders will also receive a t-shirt, Saturday dinner and Friday night rider clinic with their entry fee provided they pre-enter.
