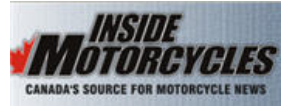

Bikes will be impounded on Saturday night.

The Course

This year's event will consist of approximately 130 km of trail each day including Extreme, MX, and Enduro tests. Riders will be divided into pro and amateur classes to allow organizers to tailor the degree of difficulty of the terrain to the rider. The amateur riders will ride the entire course. The Pro riders will have some extra sections of trail that they must complete.

Vintage, Women, and Beginner classes will run a shortened course on both Saturday and Sunday of approximately 80 to 100 km each day.

Special Tests

Special test times will be added to any route time lost for the riders total score: *Test times are not just tie breakers but are part of the riders overall score.*

MX and Extreme test courses will be laid out and marked by 9:00 am Friday, October 2nd so that riders may walk them if they wish. Directions to the tests will be available at the registration area at 9:00 am on Friday.

Sound Test

There will be a sound test. A maximum 94db will be strictly enforced (we will not lose our trails because of unnecessarily loud motorcycles). Sound testing will be open Friday, October 2nd, 7:00pm to 10:00pm and Saturday, October 3rd, 7:00am to 9:30am. Bikes must be sound tested first before riders go to registration.

Motorcycles do not have to be street legal; as a minimum, an applicable off-road registration for your state or province is required! Bikes must have head and tail lights.

Awards

Corduroy trophies will only be awarded on Sunday afternoon based on total score for both days.
